

EnOcean GmbH declares, based on the information currently available from its direct supplier and relevant upstream packaging/material suppliers, that the packaging configuration used for the relevant EnOcean module families has been reviewed for the PPWR requirements applicable from 12 August 2026.

The review covers the available packaging-family evidence for substance restrictions under Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40, including the combined heavy-metal limit for lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium, and the relevance of PFAS restrictions. ***The packaging is not intended as food-contact packaging*** in its ordinary use for EnOcean module products.

Based on the current supplier evidence, EnOcean is not aware of ***any indication that the relevant packaging intentionally contains restricted substances in a manner that would prevent alignment with the PPWR requirements applicable from 12 August 2026.***

For recyclability, EnOcean has reviewed available supplier information and will continue to apply the existing PPWD/EN 13430-style approach pending the future PPWR design-for-recycling delegated acts and assessment methodology. EnOcean notes that the detailed PPWR recyclability performance grades, recycled-content targets, harmonised sorting labelling and packaging minimisation requirements are later-stage obligations and are not finally assessed in this statement.

This statement is based on the current packaging configuration and supplier evidence available as of the date of signature. It is subject to continued supplier change control and will be updated if packaging materials, adhesives, coatings, inks, labels, suppliers, fulfilment packaging or regulatory requirements change.

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
